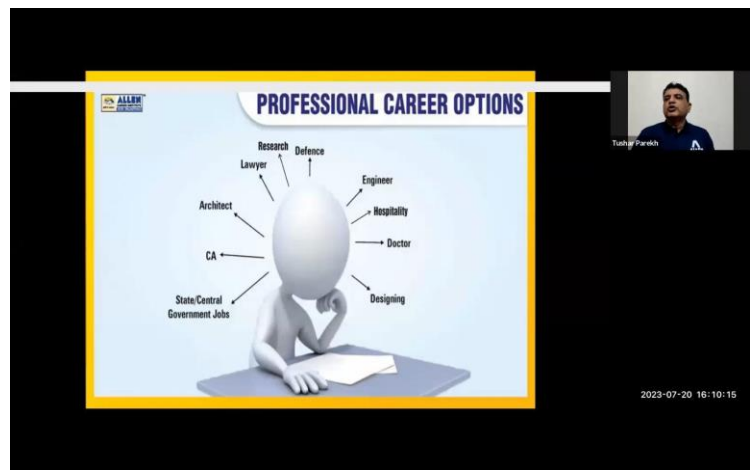

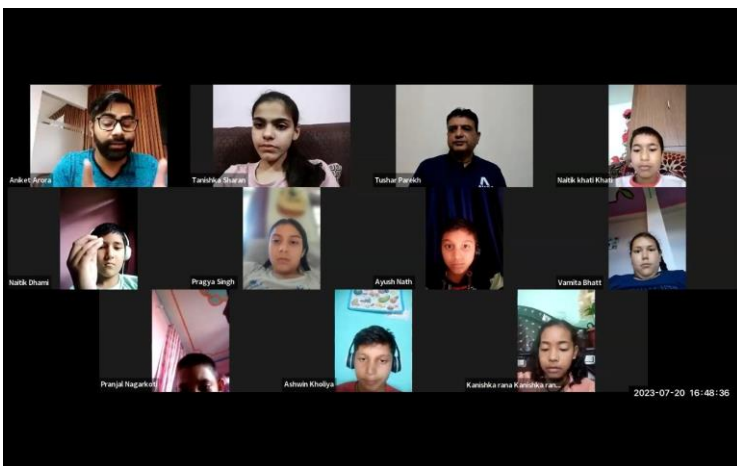
### Overview:

The session was convened by Mr. Aniket Arora, and facilitated by Mr. Tushar Parekh, (Vice President of the Allen Career Institute). He has been an academican for more than 33 years and is a National Prodigy mentor. He is the key person to developing the grade 6–10 division and also
