This is regarding the Knowledge and Awareness Mapping Platform "KAMP" - an Initiative and Knowledge Alliance of the Council of Scientific & Industrial Research (CSIR) - National Institute of Science Communication and Policy Research (NIScPR) and industrial partner M/s Nysa Communications Pvt. KAMP identifies student skills and hidden talents essential for excelling in professional life through an assessment called the National Assessment of Scientific Temperament & Aptitude (NASTA).


